This involves taking a scene from a favourite book or story and recreating it in a shoebox, using whatever materials or resources they choose. You might like to help your child with this task, as I am hoping that some of the stories chosen will reflect the increasing cultural diversity within our school community. For example, it would be great if there were storyboxes showing scenes from, for example, a traditional Polish, Hungarian, Romanian, Muslim, Sikh or Hindu tale, as well as some traditional British stories.

The storyboxes will go on display in the halls on March 2nd, and parents will be able to come and view them – more details to follow.

One more thing I would like you to consider! If you have a favourite childhood book, it would be lovely for you to come in and share it with your child's class during World Book Day week. If you think you would be interested in contributing in this way, please email the school office and they will forward your details to me. Alternatively, send your child in with a message to hand to their class teacher.
