

PE Updates

In response to recent Government guidance, we are trialling a simplified PE kit from September 2020 to help make our school as Covid-secure as we reasonably can.

The rationale for the change is to:

- 1) reduce the need for PE kits to be kept in school,
- 2) remove the need for children to change clothes during the school day,
- 3) provide a safe and comfortable PE kit for all pupils
- 4) keep it simple and affordable for parents.

From September 2020, pupils will come to school on their **main PE day** (see below) wearing their PE kit:

School white polo shirt

School blue sweatshirt

Plain black jogging bottoms/tracksuit bottoms

Royal blue PE shorts (warmer weather)

Plain trainers (preferably black). No laces for FKS/KS1

No jewellery including no earrings.

Each year group will have a designated day for PE:

Nursery - Monday

Reception - Wednesday

Year 1 - Monday

Year 2 - Thursday

Year 3 - Thursday

Year 4 - Tuesday

Year 5 - Wednesday

Year 6 - Friday

Other physical activities will be done in normal school uniform.

Hand hygiene and regular cleaning of equipment is designed to ensure that PE lessons stay safe for all. Visiting coaches will comply with the school's risk assessment, maintaining social distancing and hygiene practices.

Unfortunately, due to the current circumstances we are not able to provide swimming lessons or after school sports clubs until further notice.
